Welcome to Boston, the #1 student city in the U.S.

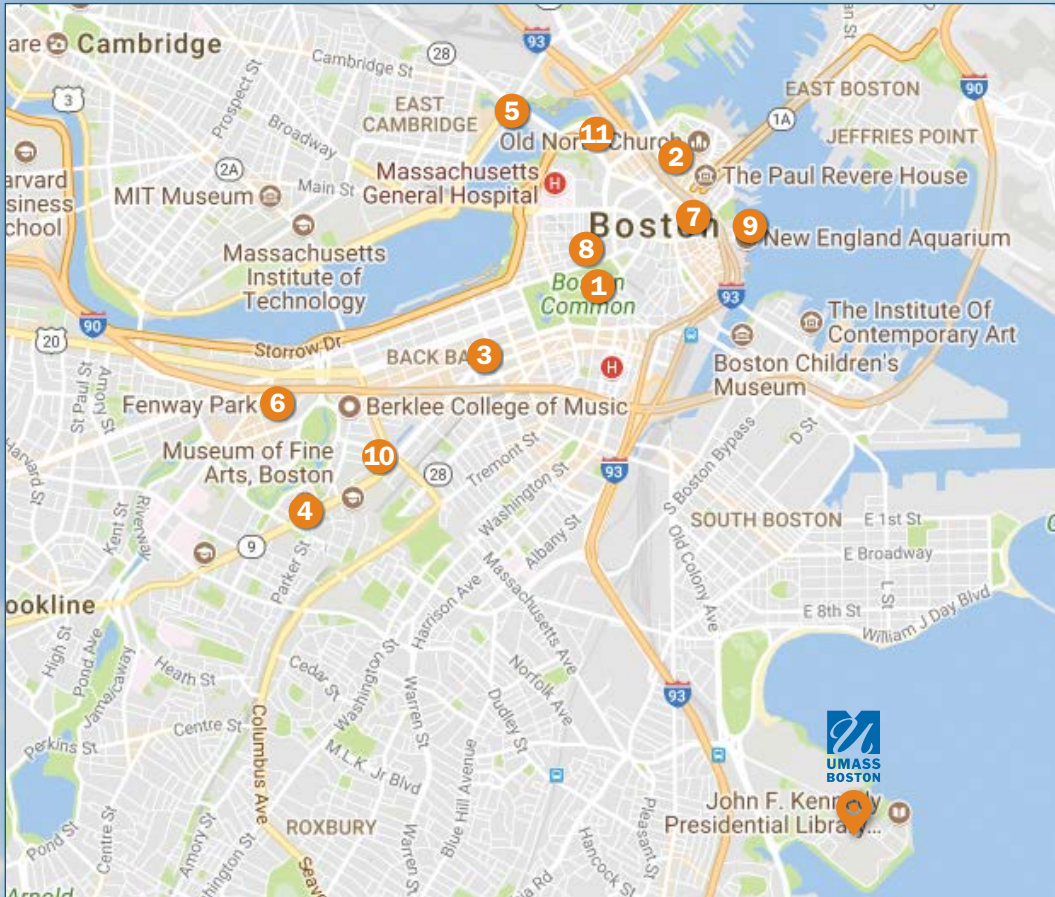

Boston neighborhoods

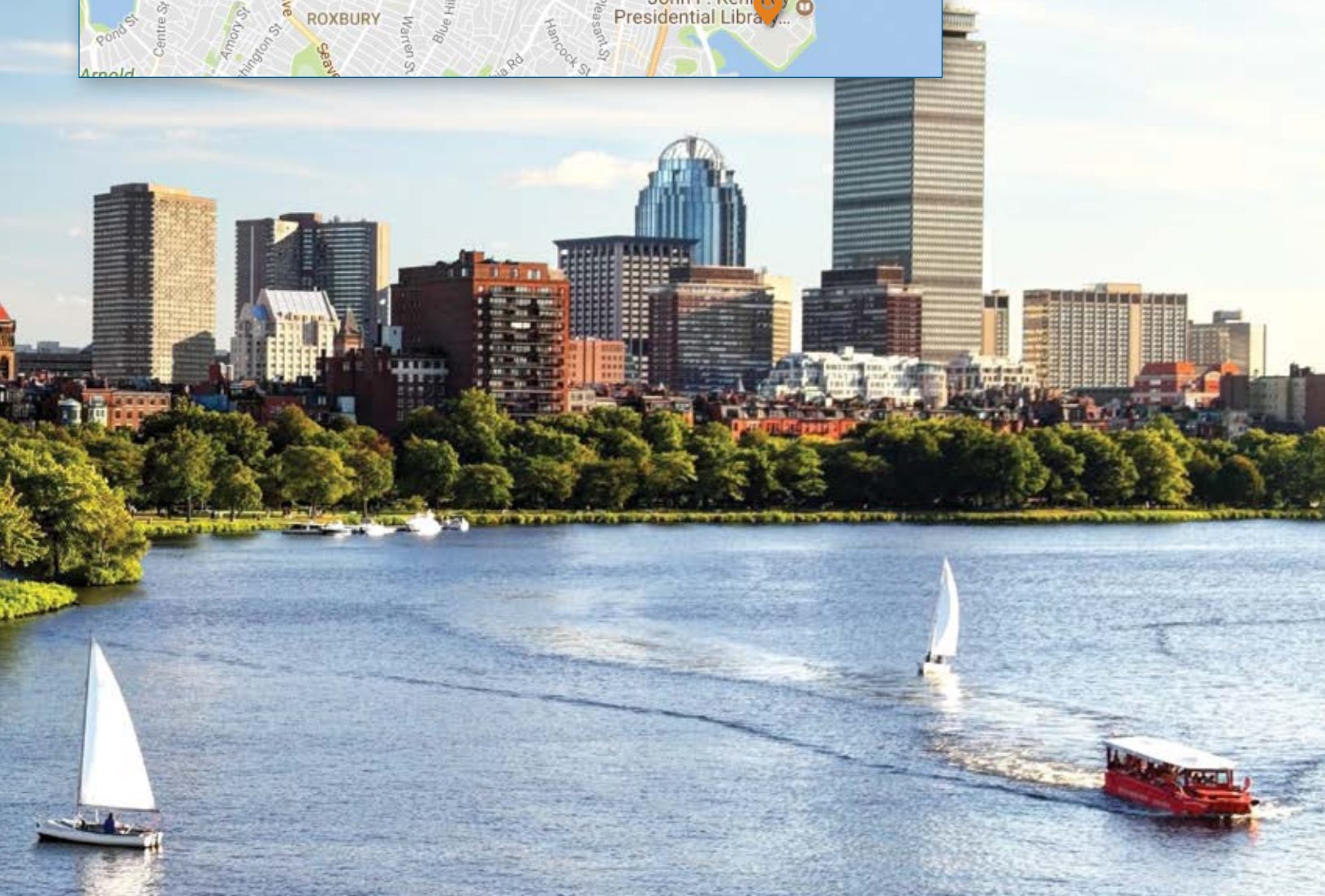

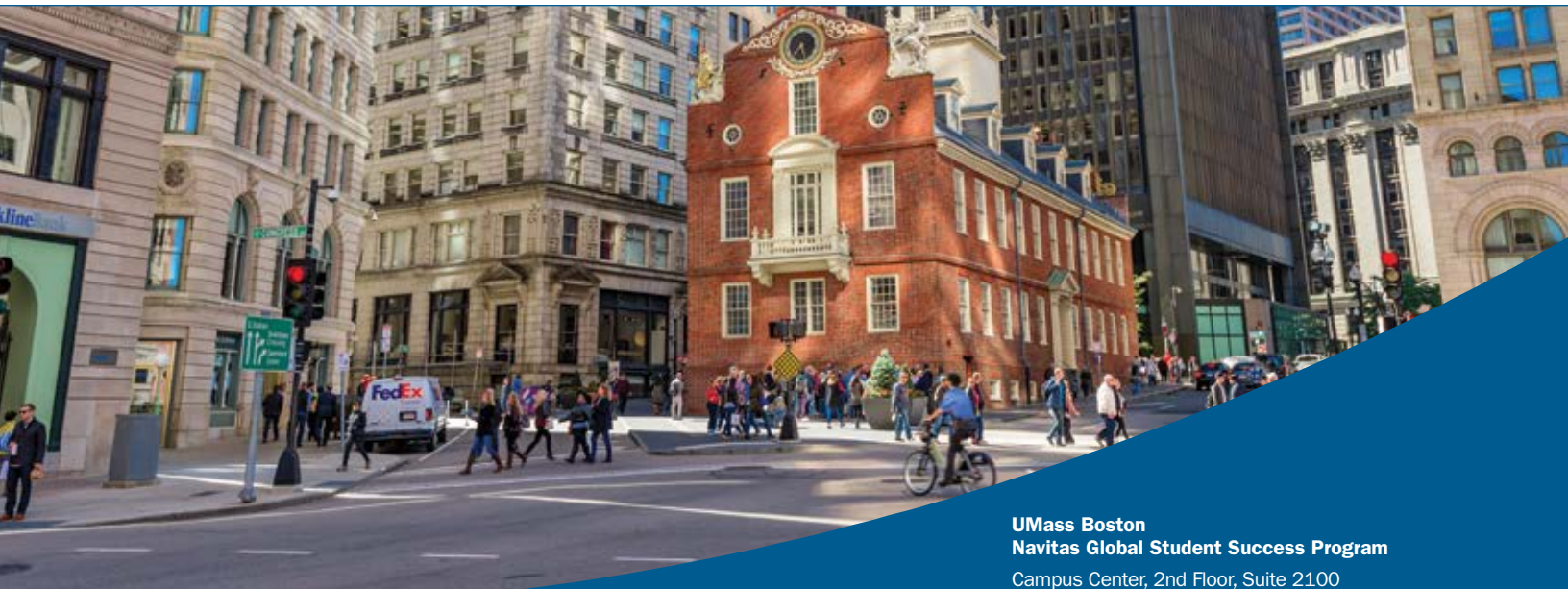
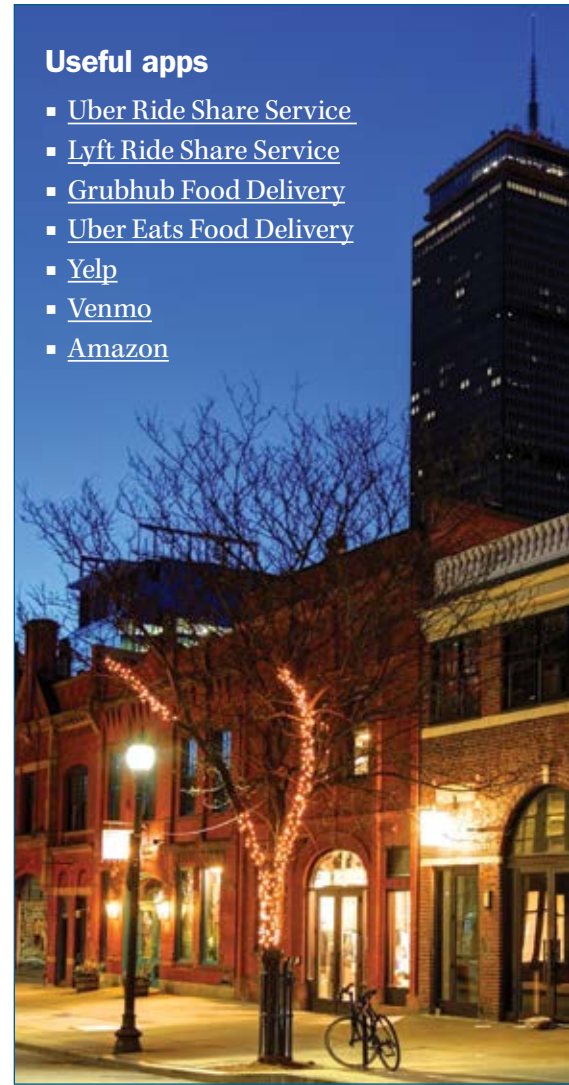
